

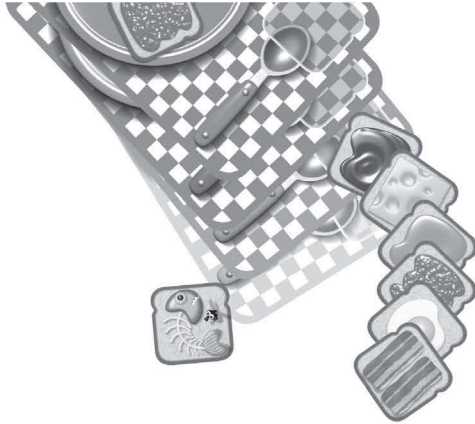
# Crazy Toaster

## RULES OF THE GAME

This crazy-cool toaster surprises you with every pop: how many toasts will jump up? You can't tell! And the toasted bread already has tons of yummy food on it, chocolate, cheese, honey, jam or egg! Quick, catch your favorite toasts and when the toaster is empty, whoever has the most in their plate has won. But beware of the stinky fish!

### CONTENTS

- 1 toaster made up of:
  - 1 body, 2 spoon-feet, 2 fork-arms,
  - 2 cup-eyes, 1 sticker sheet
- 40 slices of bread:
  - 6 spread with chocolate
  - 6 spread with honey
  - 6 spread with cheese
  - 6 spread with berry jam
  - 6 with an egg
  - 6 with bacon
  - 4 with a rotten fish
- 4 table sets printed in 4 colors
- 4 pans to catch the bread, in 4 colors



### ASSEMBLING THE TOASTER

Glue the eye stickers in the center of each cup, and the timer sticker on the nose of the toaster.

Insert the green and blue eyes in their place on the front of the toaster... looking smart!

The two forks inserted on each side give him happy arms.

And the 2 spoons fit under the device to give him a stable footing!

**We are ready!**



### BEFORE YOU START

Each player takes a plate and a pan in the same colour. Mix the 40 slices of bread and put 10 in each slot of the toaster. Position the toaster in the middle between all the players. You can start!

### PLAYING THE GAME

The player who rises the earliest begins, and play continues to the left. When every player is holding their pan, ready to catch some toasts, the first player presses down the timer-nose on the toaster.

**1 to 4 toasts will pop up from the toaster... You never know how many!**

All players try at the same time to catch the toast in their pans (no hands!).

It might take a bit of practice to catch the bread but these yummy toasts deserve a bit of work.

### Tips:

- Make no sudden moves with your pan, keep your wrist straight and your pan horizontal.
- Sometimes, you catch a toast but it bounces out of your pan. Children who are having a hard time can keep these.
- For younger children we recommend playing sitting down. This helps them not move around too much or make big arm movements.

The players who catch one or more toasts in their pan put them in their plate, if they are the right kind of spread.



If they aren't the right kind of spread, place them on the outlined square on the side of the plate.

All the slices of toast that fall to the table or the ground stay there.

When everyone is ready, the next player presses down on the nose-timer for a new round.

## THE STINKY FISH TOAST

When it falls on the table, it is the signal for the big exchange! All players who have a toast on the side of their plate can exchange it for a toast from the table or the ground that they would like to have, as long as it is "spread-side" up. Place the toast you are exchanging spread-side up on the table. Another player can take this card if they wish. You may exchange several toasts but only with cards that fell spread-side up, not bread-side.

**When all the players have finished exchanging, all the cards left on the table are removed and the next player pushes down on the timer-nose**

If you catch the stinky fish - ewww that's too bad! You must give back one of the cards you've won, either from your plate or from the square to the side of it. Place it on the table, spread-side up. Another player can take it in an exchange phase.

## END OF THE GAME

When the toaster is empty, all players count the toasts in their plate. The only toasted slices that count are those that have the same spread drawing as in your plate. The player who has the most wins.

**WARNING! Not suitable for children under 3. Choking hazard, small parts.**
